- Ensure 85% of students achieve a C or above in English
- Ensure 90% of students achieve regional reading targets

Our initiatives include


- Implementation of whole school reading and writing program
- Employ additional classroom teaching positions to reduce class sizes
- Employ additional support teacher position to support an inclusive support programs
- Employ additional speech language pathology services
- Implement year level case management approach to supporting identified students
- Implement increased speech therapy services for identified students
- Collect & analyse school based data to inform intervention & support model
- Collaborative planning sessions for all teachers each term
