**\$443,394\***

## This funding will be used to

- Ensure 90% of students achieve a C or above in English in Prep – Year 2
- Ensure 55% of students achieve a B or above in English in Prep – Year 2
- Increase the % of students in the U2Bs for Reading above SQSS
- Increase the % of Students with a Disability achieving a C or above in English
- Ensure 95% of students reach NMS for Reading
- Ensure 90% of indigenous students reach NMS for Reading.

## Our initiatives include

- Implementation of whole school reading
- Employ additional classroom teaching positions to reduce class sizes
- Employ additional support teacher position to support an inclusive support program
- Employ additional speech language pathology services
- Implement year level case management approach to supporting identified students
- Implement increased speech therapy services for identified students
- Collect & analyse school-based data to inform intervention & support model
- Collaborative planning sessions for all teachers each term.
